Pie chart represents the birdlife observed during the 2008 - 2009 early morning (5:30 - 6:30) timed surveys, Rotuma Island

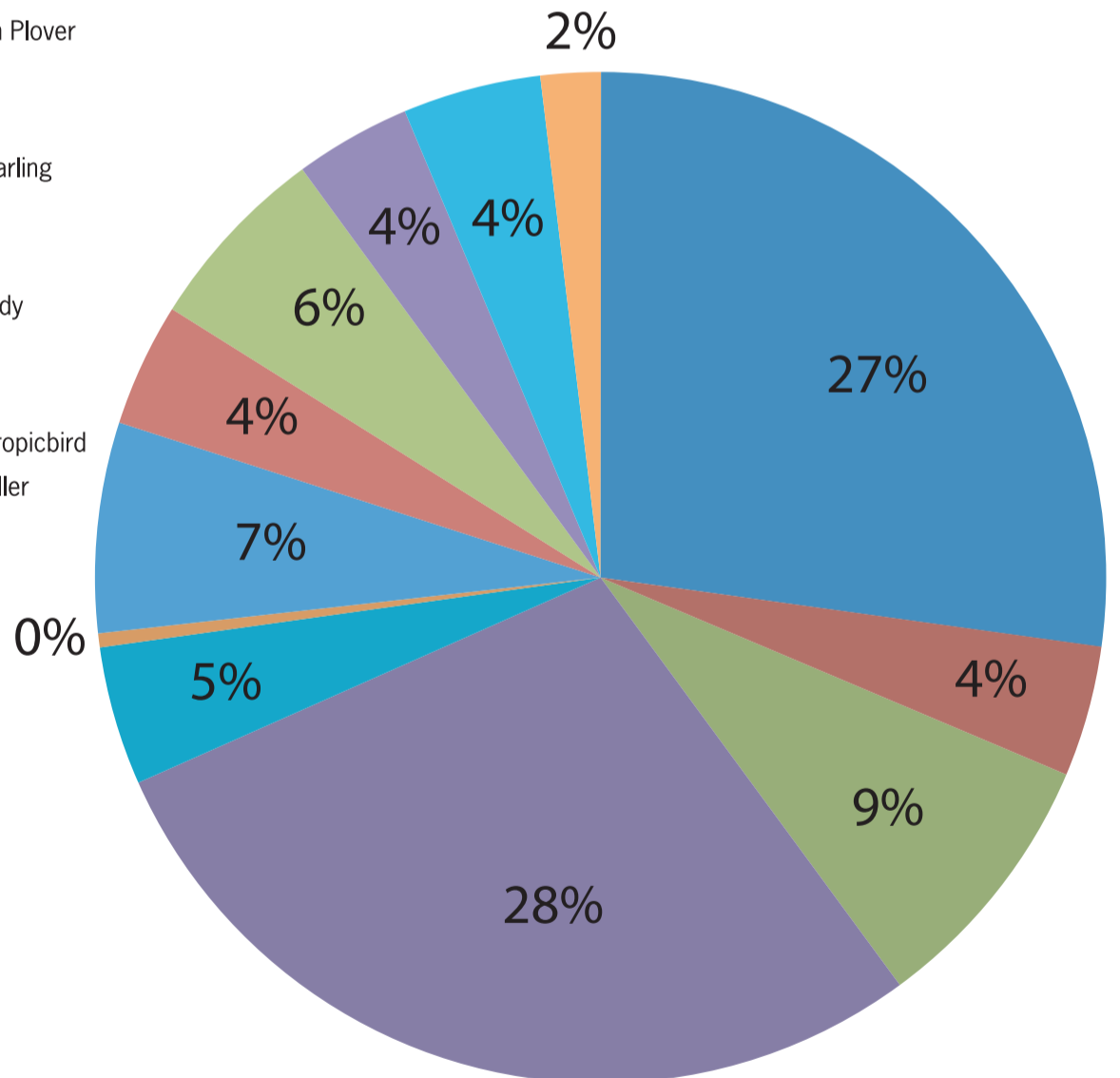

The early morning bird surveys show observation of 12 types of birds. In groups of 2-3 people, they are allocated across three zones: up the forest and plantation areas, the backyard which fringe village settings and towards the coastal area within 100m of the beach. Armea, the Rotuman Honeyeater and Pacific Pigeon, l'pa are the two most common birds observed during the early morning timed surveys at Rotuma.
